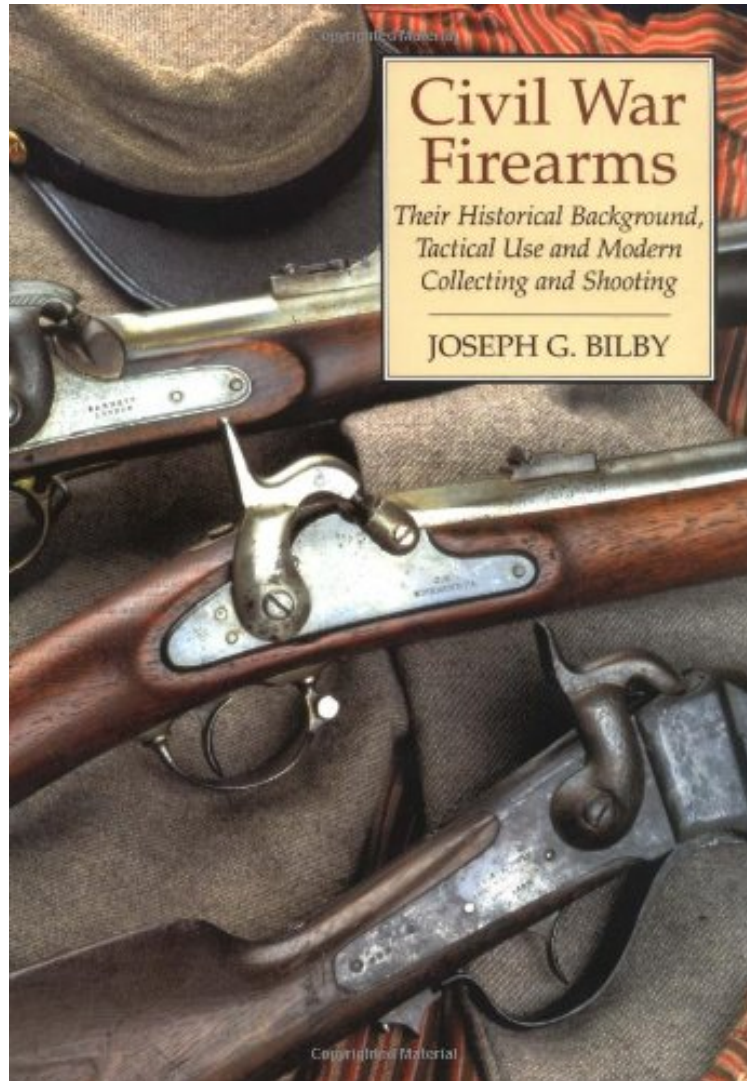

The cover looks great but the photos inside are very poor, almost like they were photocopied from a black and white newspaper. If you're looking for detailed photos or even halfway decent photos of the weapons of the Civil War, this isn't it by a long shot. So three stars is all it gets based on lack of good photos. Disappointed.
