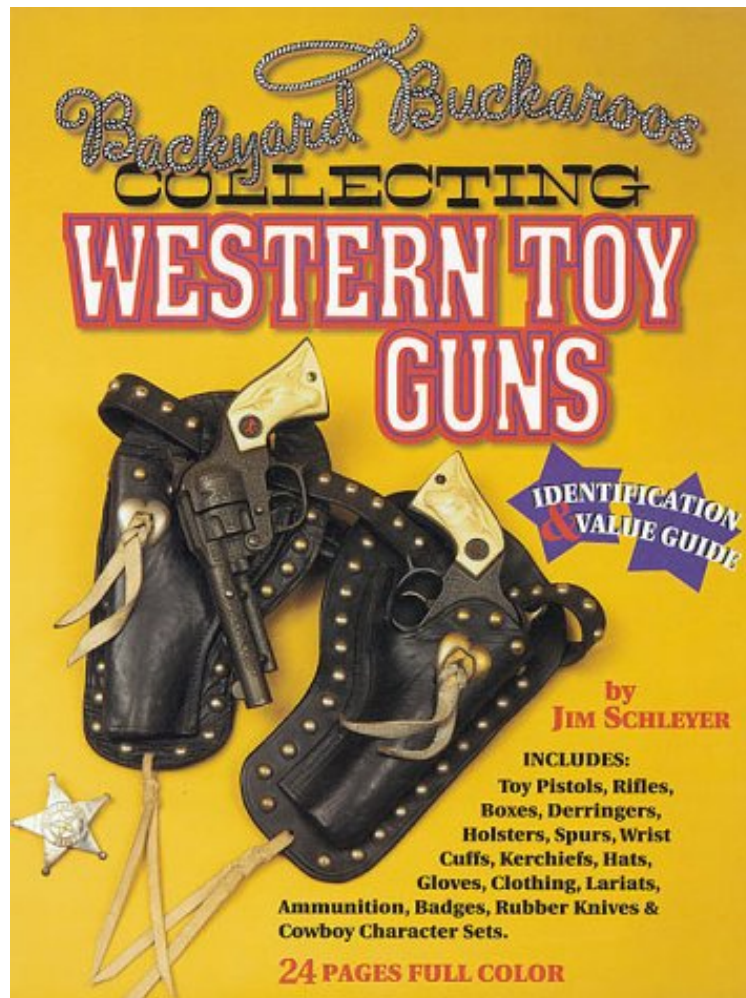

This is over 450 pages of great information not fully covered in other cap gun books. You would be hard pressed to not find a BW photo and info about every cap gun you have. About 24 pages in the middle of the book are in full color. If you could only have one book on this subject, this would be it. As far as the price guides shown, you have to consider this, and the other books available, were written before eBay became popular. Hence, I feel the prices are a bit high for eBay, but probably right on for antique shops, high end auctions, and especially on-line vintage toy dealers. Price guides do give a idea that gun A is worth more or less than gun B. If you really want a "price guide", run a "advanced search" on eBay for items that were
