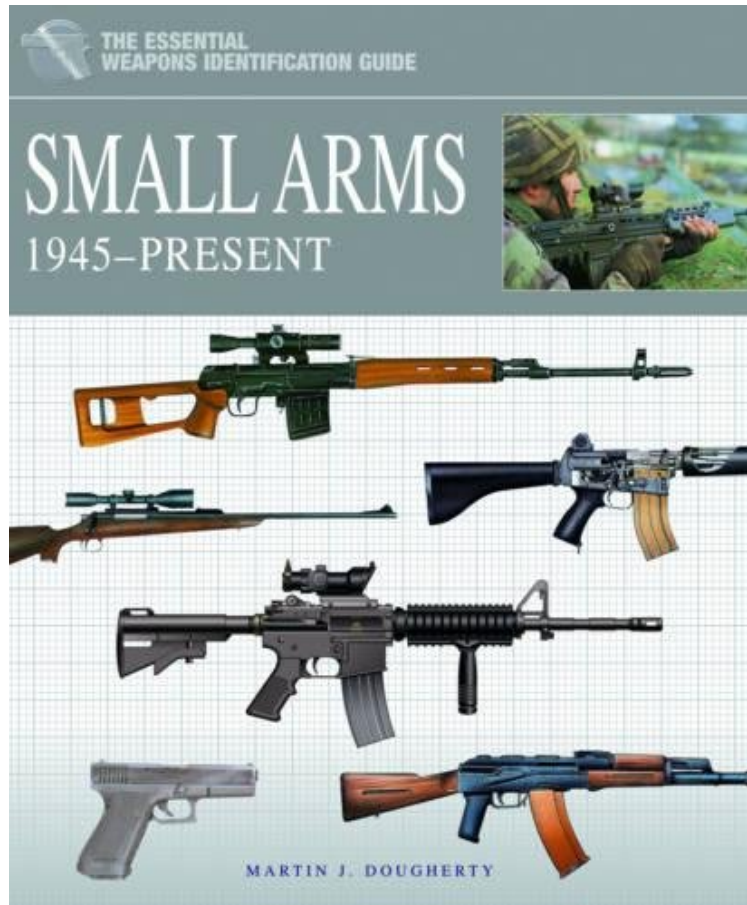

I had these criticisms to offer once I'd read it.First, the printing of the pictures is sometimes distorted, as if the photo was placed on a rubber sheet and then stretched out. This doesn't occur often but I wouldn't expect it to occur at all in a costly book.Second, the editing is poor. Sometimes pictures of one type of weapon are labeled with captions that are incorrect. It seems like

the photos were accidentally switched at some point and no one caught it. Finally, some of the weapons are only presented as "cutaways." If I wanted pictures of the interior of weapons I would refer to the Numerich gun parts catalog, or to some of my books which are particularly concerned with gun repair and show exploded diagrams. This may be a personal quirk but it irritated me. You can do better for the amount of money this book costs.

Illustrated with outstanding color profile artworks, *The Essential Identification Guide: Small Arms 1945–Present* is the definitive study of the small arms equipment of warring nations from the end of World War II, through the Cold War to the current conflict in Afghanistan. Arranged chronologically and by theater of war, the book describes in depth the various models in service with each force, noting the changing uses of small arms and the development of the role of high-powered sniper rifles, such as the M110. All the key types of small arms are featured, such as handguns, submachine guns, machine guns, automatic rifles and grenade launchers, and all the major models are included, such as the M16 rifle, the AK-47, Uzi and the Gepard M1. The book covers the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the Six Day War, Yom Kippur War, the Yugoslav War, Chechnya, Iraq and Afghanistan. With information boxes accompanying the full-color artworks, *The Essential Identification Guide: Small Arms 1945–Present* is an excellent reference guide for modelers and any enthusiast with an interest in the military technology of the twentieth century.
